Requirements for Installation

In order to carry out the installation, an operating system approved for the version to be installed has to be installed on the system. Microsoft Windows 10 and Microsoft Windows 11 are approved only in the 64-bit version respectively. For further information, please find the software approvals for version 2023. The software approvals are available at

https://www.eplan.help/en-us/Infoportal/Content/htm/portal_software_approvals.htm.

Administrator rights are required for the installation and for the first start after installation of the software.

In order to work with EPLAN Education the user must have write privileges for the directories in which the software stores data. These generally are:

- The program directory
- The directory of the original master data
- The system master data directory
- The directories for the settings databases
 - o User
 - Workstation
 - Company
- The directory for the log file EplLog.txt

The free memory required for the software and master data must be available.


Microsoft Office 64-bit or an SQL Server is required for the project management and foreign language database.



Installation

Start the installation by accessing your download directory via the explorer and double-clicking the Setup.exe file in the root directory.

Program selection and registration



The first window of the installation lists the available program Education.

You can also find the registration form here. To be able to use EPLAN Education you have to register here. This is necessary for the activation to be assigned and to be correspondingly generated.




Therefore, please use the form integrated in the setup and send us your data.

We will check the plausibility of the data you entered. After the check we will send your personal Entitlement ID (EID) to the e-mail address you specified. This e-mail also contains a link to create your EPLAN ID. To create your EPLAN ID for the Education version, use the link in the e-mail and follow the instructions.

If at that time you do not have Internet access or skipped the registration, you can register at a later time on the Internet by running the Setup.exe file again.

License agreement

In the second window of the installation, you have to accept the license agreement to continue with the installation. The license agreement is automatically confirmed when you continue the setup via the **Next** button.






Directories of the EPLAN Setup Manager

The third window handles the directory settings and the company code. Please note: These settings have an effect on the future use of the software.


The following settings are suggested as the default for the installation of EPLAN Education. These can be accepted as they are. However, since data is generally stored on a server drive at most customers, it makes sense to customize these settings. The company code should always be adapted. It will also be included in the folder structure created by the installation.





Program components, Master data types and Language modules

The components to be installed are displayed in the fourth window.



The language entered at **Activated** is used for the user interface when the software is started, in as far as it is licensed.

After the **Install** button has been clicked, the installation of *EPLAN Education* is started.

In the course of the installation the upper section of the Setup Manager provides information about the installation status.

Any warning that may be displayed in the middle section of the EPLAN Setup Manager does not have any influence on the installation itself. If you confirm this message and allow the execution of the content, further information about the EPLAN Platform 2023 is displayed in the lower section.


The first start of EPLAN Education must be carried out with administrator rights, like the installation itself.

Activation of the license

At the start of EPLAN Education the activation of your Entitlement ID is required. Directly after starting the software by the Icon the license manager opens. Select the menu Single-user license and call up the menu item Activate license online.



Then insert the Entitlement ID you have received by e-mail into the following dialog.




The first start of EPLAN Education requires somewhat longer than the subsequent start procedures. This is because the following actions have to be carried out during the first start: Generation of the directory structure for the system master data and copying of the original master data into the system master data directories.



The EPLAN Identity Client and EPLAN ID

In the last step of the EPLAN Education 2023 startup process, the EPLAN Identity Client opens.



Here you have to log in with your EPLAN ID. In order to do this, you use your login that you created during the registration process.

Please note that the EPLAN Education version is restricted in its accessibility and functionality regarding the EPLAN Cloud.
